The ark, about 75% complete, is constructed of cypress wood from Louisiana bayous. The ark is currently housed on property in Sevier County, attached to a permanent base. Animals are ready to board! Hopefully this project will beat the 120 years Noah worked.

Further construction could continue on that property or the ark could be moved to fenced property in northeast Knox County, if that location is closer for the volunteer.
