

What is the Gospel?

The Gospel is the only good news that saves men's souls.

(1) "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God."

Romans 3:23

(2) The penalty for falling short of God's glory is death; (but instead of this second eternal death) we can receive His free gift which is eternal life in Christ Jesus, our Lord.

Romans 6:23

(3) But God proves His love toward us this way: even before we were sinners Jesus Christ died for us.

Romans 5:8

(4) "Whoever will call upon the name of the Lord will be saved."

Joel 2:32, Acts 2:21**

(5) As many as receive Him He gives the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name.

John 1:12

(6) "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever (that's you) believes in Him should not perish (experience the second eternal death), but have everlasting life."

John 3:16

(7) God sent His Son into the world not to condemn you and me, but that through Christ Jesus we should be saved.

John 3:17

(8) Jesus says to us, "He who hears My Word, and believes My Father who sent Me, has eternal life and is not judged with the damned, but has passed out of eternal death into eternal life."

John 5:24

(9) Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice and I know them and they follow Me; and I give eternal life to them; and they shall never perish; and no one shall snatch them out of My hand."

John 10:27-28

(10) These words explaining the gospel have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the anointed One, the Son of God, and that by believing Him you may have life in His Name.
